

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Good News Club[®] Report:

As of November 10, we will have 20 Good News Clubs taking place in Lansing, Holt, and Mason.



Lansing Schools: Cumberland, Gier Park, Riddle, Reo, Kendon

Holt Schools: Wilcox

Mason Schools: North Aurelius and Steele Elementary

There are four daycare clubs, five clubs at different churches, one club in a home, and one club at a homeless shelter.

We are thankful for the 29 people that are involved in teaching these clubs each week.

Testimony from a GNC[™] teacher: “As I was waiting in the hallway for the children to be dismissed from their classrooms, children who have never come to *Good News Club* came up to me and said, ‘You are Mrs. Hammar with the *Good News Club*.’ I was surprised to know that children who don’t even come to club know who we are and why we are there.”

Building and Finances

We praise God for His provision for this ministry. Because many of you choose to give to this ministry, more children can hear the Gospel as we work to train and equip others to share the Gospel with the boys and girls.

We have been in this building since May of 2003. There are some repairs and improvements that need to be made. All the light fixtures in the basement need to be upgraded. On the main floor, there are four rooms where we need to replace the light fixtures. We are in the process of looking at quotes from different lighting contractors. This will cost approximately \$800.

We would like to paint the basement walls and the ceilings on the main floor after the new lighting fixtures are installed.

Noah's Ark: In 2012, we had a beautiful new Noah's Ark built through the generosity of a Sunday school class at South Church. Sadly, the wood on that ark rotted because of leaking issues. We have been using another trailer painted as Noah's Ark that was available from another CEF of MI chapter. That trailer is leaking and needs to be rebuilt. The husband of one of our committee members is willing to do the work for the cost of the materials. The estimated cost of that is \$2,000. We also need a place to park the trailer while it is being rebuilt.



Financial Needs:

Current operations: \$10,000 per month is needed at current wages and operating expenses.

Lighting: \$800

Paint and supplies: \$200

Noah's Ark: \$2,000 and a place to rebuild the trailer.

Looking ahead: In order for the staff to be fully supported (Doug and Maryann Hammar—already full time; Elias being able to be full time), monthly contributions received need to be \$14,000.

Please continue to pray for God to supply the needed funds so that more boys and girls will hear the life-saving message of salvation in Jesus Christ in an ever-increasing hostile world.

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
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Teaching Children Effectively Level 1
