WORD UP! God is faithful!


You have a new memory verse this week.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!


God is faithful. He always does what He says He will do! Because God is faithful you can depend on Him. You can depend on Him when life is easy and when life is hard.

—Philippians 4:19


3 PRAY ABOUT IT!
