—*Philippians 1:6*

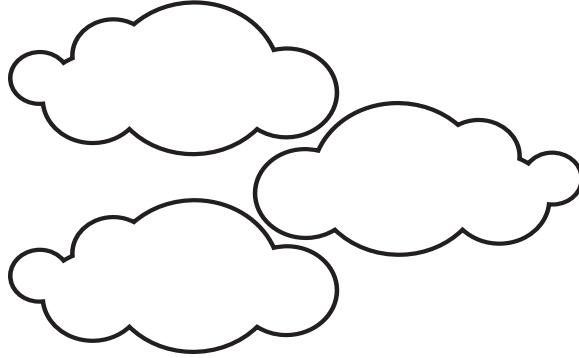
3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

This week you learned a new memory verse—do you have it memorized? See if you can say the verse by using just the first letter of each word.

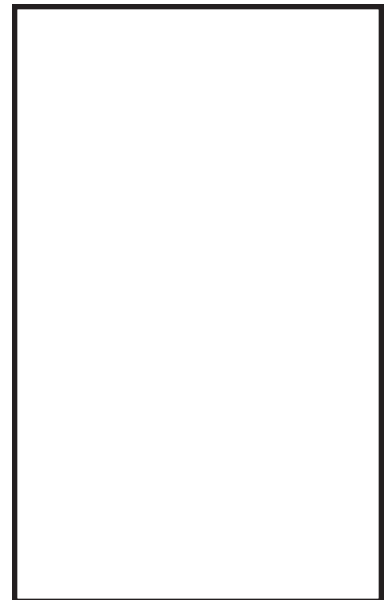
