Good News Club®

"Good News Club[®] is so fun!"

We love to hear these words come out of the mouths of the children that attend *Good News Club*. When they run to the room where the club meets each week, you know they are very excited to be there.

Clubs have started at Attwood, North, and Riddle schools in Lansing; Alaiedon, North Aurelius, and Steele Schools in Mason; two released time clubs that meet monthly; two clubs that meet at churches, and the biweekly club at the City Rescue Mission of Lansing.

In a recent club, as the teacher was talking about the red page of *The Wordless Book* and showing the visual that went with it, one boy said, "That shouldn't have happened. Jesus shouldn't have died. Those others guys were being punished for their sin, but Jesus had no sin." The teacher reminded the boy (and all the children) that Jesus did have to die in order for your sin and mine to be forgiven.

At the *Good News Club* at Riddle Elementary, three children responded to the invitation to trust Jesus as Savior. Many children at the school are asking for permission slips. God also brought two helpers from unexpected places.

This was shared by the GNC[™] worker at the City Rescue Mission: "As the teacher was ending the Bible lesson, she declared the mothers were waiting so we would close. One little girl, age five, looked at me surprised and said, 'We're done already?! But that's not fair! I wanted to keep learning!"

A girl at a Mason school attended *Good News Club* at another school last year and thought she would miss out on attending this year. When she heard her new school had a *Good News Club*, she was so excited and eager to attend.

Chapter Finances

We are so thankful for the special gifts that have been received from many individuals. Those special gifts help to meet the shortfall in regular giving.

Here is a breakdown of expenses anticipated for 2024. These numbers do not include any raises, increase of hours for Elias, or adding another part time staff member.

General Fund, training, fundraising	\$3,790 per month needed
Club and fair ministry	\$541 per month needed
Staff wages	\$7,483 per month needed
Total monthly need	\$11,814

In order for this ministry to grow, more staff is needed. For more staff to be added, more funds will be needed to pay them a competitive wage.

Currently, each of the staff are receiving an hourly wage that compares to a worker at McDonalds or less. Elias desires to be full time and needs an hourly wage that will support him and his wife. Vivian Brown, a young lady who has been a summer missionary for four years, desires to join the staff.
