Our goal is to raise \$15,000 to cover the cost of the boiler, installation, and any unexpected materials that may need to be purchased in order to complete the installation. At this time we have received \$8,920 toward this need.

As you pray for God to provide the finances for a new boiler, please also pray for His provision for the regular expenses of ministry, like staff support, club ministry, office expenses, and mileage reimbursement. Contributions for staff support are about \$1,100 less than what is needed each month to meet payroll.
