Good News Club®

God has provided our chapter with wonderful *Good News Club* teachers and helpers so that we can have clubs in 9 schools, a church, the City Rescue Mission of Lansing, and 2 Release Time Clubs held in 2 different churches. As of December, there are 214 children enrolled in these clubs and 17 children have trusted Christ as their Savior!

One church donated their old pew Bibles and we have been able to give them out to over 20 children at the Release Time Club in Durand. Several children have responded to the salvation invitation at this club. As we ask them questions concerning their understanding of the Gospel, it has been challenging to guide them from false teachings to the truth of God's Word. There seems to be a big focus on "spirits" of loved ones or pets who have died mixed with truths from the Bible. It is very confusing for the children.

For many children who attend, the club is their church and that is the only time during the week they hear the truth of God and His Word. Pray for wisdom for all of our *GNC*[®] workers as they help guide the children to the Savior and teach those believing children what God would want them to do.

We are excited about a new club starting at Greyhound Intermediate School in the Eaton Rapids School District. First Baptist Church of Eaton Rapids has formed a team and is ready to begin this club in February.

Christmas Party Clubs



Christmas Party Club™ is now an official ministry of CEF. We praise God for the two extra Christmas Party Clubs that took place outside of normal Good News Clubs this December.

After doing a Christmas Party Club training for people at Grove Bible Church, they went to a mobile home park in St. Johns and taught the children the true meaning of Christmas.

Elias was able to have people from his church who recently completed the Teaching Children Effectively 1 course help at a CPC at his church where 8 children attended.

On Saturday, January 4, we had a Christian Youth In Action ™ Blast—a CYIA™ student and staff reunion. The highlights were the Nerf dart war, Guess the Bible Book name, Light the Christmas tree game, and the CYIA True and False game.
