A child who previously made the decision to trust Christ as her Savior came back to the counseling table. She said, "I just wanted to tell you that this week I sinned. But then I did it. I asked Jesus to forgive me and He did!"

A first-grade girl told the club teacher that she prayed to receive Jesus as her Savior as she was leaving club for the day. Another girl was counseled for salvation a few weeks after responding to the invitation just to be sure she truly is saved.

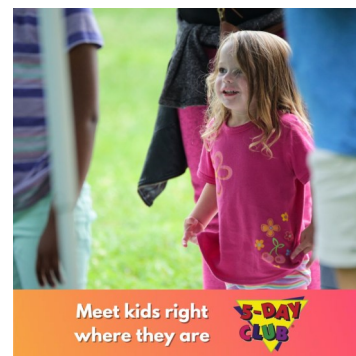

God continues to provide for this ministry and we are so grateful to each one that He has used to help boys and girls hear the life-changing message of salvation. We praise God that a church just voted to add Vivian Yoder as a CEF missionary to their missions budget. That will help immensely.

In order to meet the needs of the 2025 budget, the total needed per month is \$12,357. In January, we had \$10,483 come in, so that means we were \$1,874 short for the month.
